At the hearing on December 20, 2004, the Defense and the Prosecution reported to the Court that they would meet and confer regarding the discovery issues raised in the Defense Motion to Compel Discovery.

The parties have met and conferred. Many of the issues have been resolved. One issue that has not yet been resolved concerns the Prosecution's Bates numbering. The Prosecution has produced approximately 24,585 pages.

The Defense learned that it has a set of documents bearing Bates numbers that are different from those of the Prosecution's. It appears that the Prosecution produced documents to the Defense without keeping a copy. Alternatively, the Prosecution kept a copy, but numbered another set of documents differently.

The Defense attempted to resolve this numbering disarray, but was unsuccessful.

The details will be explained in open court tomorrow.
